

1 Peter 2:24-25

Peter says Jesus bore our sins in his body on the tree. Why did he need to bear our sins? What Old Testament picture does bearing our sins bring to mind? How does his love help us bear up under the troubles and persecutions which afflict us?

Peter says we were like sheep going astray. Do we still go astray? What are some characteristics that sheep have that Christians also do?

Peter says Jesus is our shepherd. What is a shepherd's function? In what ways does Jesus function as our shepherd? Why is it nice to have a shepherd like Jesus?

Jesus is also our overseer. What is the function of an overseer? In what ways does Jesus function as our overseer? Why is it nice to have an overseer like Jesus?
